The Ride: The [Dust Devils M/C](#) is proud to host another exciting, [AMA](#) sanctioned, Dual Sport ride through Nevada's high desert and California's most scenic terrain in and around the Sierra Nevada Mountains. Come join us for 2 days and 200+ fun-filled miles of the best Dual Sport Riding you're likely to encounter anywhere! Please note that this is a non-competitive, self-guided tour on designated routes using roll charts provided by DDMC. Supplemental Garmin GPS tracks and waypoints may also be available, but please bring a USB cable for uploading.

Entry: **Pre-Entry Deadline is September 18, 2009.** Cost is \$95 for the two-day package, includes both days Roll Charts, One T-Shirt, One Buffet Banquet Ticket and One Raffle Ticket. Passengers ride free! The Saturday Only package is \$75 and includes Roll Chart, One T-Shirt, One Buffet Banquet Ticket and One raffle ticket. Passengers ride free! **Post-Entry Prices are \$115 and will be available on a first come, first served basis, and T-Shirts size and availability cannot be guaranteed.**

The Banquet / Buffet Dinner: There will be a Banquet Dinner on Saturday night, October 4th. Your ticket includes one entry to the dinner. A "No Host" bar will be available. The evening's program includes recognition of other Dual Sport Clubs, our Sponsors and Volunteers. There will also be thousands of dollars of gear and prizes, generously donated by our sponsors, given away during the raffle. Additional Banquet tickets are available for \$28 if purchased by September 19, 2008 (*after, based on availability*). Additional raffle tickets will be available at the banquet.

Bike Requirements: A re-settable odometer and a roll chart holder are required for navigational purposes. Garmin format GPS tracks may be available to use as a supplement, however, please bring your own USB compatible data cable for uploading. Your bike must have a [USFS](#) approved spark arrestor and be street legal. The [US Forest Service](#), who grants our permits, is also concerned about non-native plants being introduced into the forest, so please wash your bike well before coming to the event. A simple tech-inspection will be conducted. No Pass = No Ride, No Refund. An optional sound check for "educational" purposes will also be available to encourage low noise footprints.
